Firecall Facility

- Support using a passphrase as well as a password to revalidate access to the user's logonid.
- Added the ALL-SMS firecall privilege. ALL-SMS allows a user access to any resource in the MGMTCLAS [\$TYPE(MGM)] and STORCLAS [\$TYPE(STR)] classes that govern use of these parameters for dataset allocation. Within the bounds of the SMS ACS routines, this allows the user to allocate datasets under any MGMTCLAS or STORCLAS defined to the system.
